

Course Description

The Certified Trainer Equipment Inspector Series is specifically for those looking to teach FallTech's 4-hour Equipment Inspector course. The program begins with participants completing the Equipment Inspector course as students. This first step not only builds essential knowledge about fall protection equipment and inspection standards but also allows participants to experience the course exactly as their future students will. Following this, the training shifts to a focused instructor development process, where participants learn how to deliver the course effectively, manage the classroom, conduct practical inspection activities, guide students through hands-on equipment evaluations, and lead meaningful discussions. Emphasis is placed on understanding the course structure, using the provided materials, and practicing delivery techniques. By the end of the program, trainers will be prepared to confidently deliver FallTech's Equipment Inspector training and support proper equipment inspection practices in the field.



Duration: 2 Days

Course Objectives

- Build a strong working knowledge of the equipment, inspection procedures, and applicable safety standards.
- Gain a clear understanding of FallTech's Equipment Inspector course structure, content, and learning objectives.

Target Audience: This course is designed for individuals responsible for training others on how to conduct formal inspections of fall protection equipment. Participants should have a basic understanding of fall protection equipment before attending to ensure they can effectively follow and apply the inspection procedures covered in the course. Individuals without prior fall protection knowledge or experience are strongly encouraged to complete a basic Authorized Person fall protection training course before enrolling in this program.

Course Format: This course combines classroom instruction with hands-on activities. Participants will actively work through the trainer guide materials in preparation for teaching others. The program focuses on practical skill development, providing opportunities to lead inspection exercises, practice course delivery, and receive valuable feedback. By the end of the course, participants will be ready to confidently deliver FallTech's Equipment Inspector course and guide students through proper inspection techniques.

Course Materials: Program attendees will receive a complete instructor kit with all materials needed to deliver the course, including trainer guides and all related instructional resources, along with access to FallTech's Trainer Presenter tool for slideshow presentations.
